Nurse Practitioner Locum Relief Contract, up to 17.5 hours per week May to August 2018

The Four Villages Community Health Centre has two locations in the west end of Toronto. It is funded by the Toronto Central LHIN. Four Villages' mandate is to provide high quality, accessible primary health care to the communities within its service area, in the context of the broader social determinants of health. Primary care, clinical services and a wide range of health promotion programs are primarily aimed at seniors, families with young children, youth and newcomers. Staff collaborate in an inter-professional team environment. The focus is on the client and capacity building.

As a valuable member of the interdisciplinary primary health care team, the Nurse Practitioner provides primary health care to individuals and families.

We are currently seeking an experienced Nurse Practitioner to join our inter-professional team to provide locum coverage during the months of May to August 2018.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provides ongoing comprehensive primary health care to clients of all ages within the Nurse Practitioner scope of practice, including assessment, diagnosis, counseling, screening, referral, education, treatment and follow-up;
- Initiates and manages the care of clients and/or monitors the ongoing therapy of clients with acute and chronic illnesses. Where necessary and appropriate consults with other members of the team to provide interventions, within the current scope of practice. Monitors client health maintenance, and, in cooperation with the client (and their family, if appropriate) and other members of the inter-professional, team develops health care plans and recommendations concerning treatment, prevention and health promotion options;
- Promotes awareness of and participation in Centre activities;
- Incorporates and strengthens collaborative and inter-professional work;
- Maintains complete and accurate client records, assessment notes and required correspondence;
- Safeguards client records, assures confidentiality of client information, and seeks to minimize risk.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Baccalaureate or higher degree in Nursing from a recognized university;
- Certificate as a Primary Care Nurse Practitioner from a recognized institution;
- Current registration in the Extended Class with the College of Nurses of Ontario;
- Three to five years nursing experience in a community primary care setting, preferably in an under serviced area, or in combination of community and hospital or public health settings;
- Knowledge and experience with therapeutic methods and practices based upon a health promotion/illness prevention model;
- Demonstrated ability, commitment to and knowledge of community health care;
- Demonstrated ability to work in an inter-professional team environment;
- Proficiency in the use of computers and appropriate software applications;
- Excellent interpersonal skills;
- Excellent communication, decision-making, problem-solving, conflict management and time management skills;

Hours of work: up to 17.5 hours per week (including one evening)

Salary: Hourly wage: \$49.31 to \$53.85 depending on level of experience plus 10% in lieu of benefits
